Studies by the researchers from the University of Cambridge show compelling evidence that the victims, including children under the age of six, were killed in a single event. Many of the skeletons were found face down; others were found in a position that suggests they were bound, including a woman in the late stages of pregnancy. Researchers, also, recovered the bones of the nine-month-old fetus.

The study fuels the idea that human warfare is as old as we are. Fortunately man has been able to control his violent nature to a limited degree or civilization probably wouldn't exist. However the veneer of civilization is thin.
